What is being proposed?

An application has been submitted to the Council seeking to renew The Brighton Marina Business Neighbourhood Forum which was originally designated in 18 June 2015. The forum's designation lasts for 5 years and expired on 18 June 2020. **If the renewal of the Forum is approved then the neighbourhood forum will be able to continue to draw up a neighbourhood development plan for the area.**

How does it affect you?

Neighbourhood planning gives local people who live, work, or are elected representatives in an area the right to draw up a neighbourhood plan, setting out a vision for future development in the area. **If the forum designation is made, no other organisation can be designated to draw up a neighbourhood plan for the area.**


How can you get involved?
